
THE MEADOWLANDS PARKWAY BRIDGE

About the Project

Hudson County in coordination with the North Jersey Transportation Planning Authority (NJTPA) and the New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) are conducting a Local Concept Development (LCD) study to determine appropriate improvements to the Meadowlands Parkway Bridge.
